Guidelines for Funeral Mass and for Funeral Liturgy Outside Mass at the Basilica Cathedral of St. John the Baptist - Revised November 5th, 2021

The Funeral Home will call the Basilica with a contact number for the family when the family of a deceased parishioner contacts them in order to set the date and time of the Funeral Mass or Funeral Service (Liturgy of the Word without Mass) with the Parish – 754-2170

- The Basilica Bereavement ministry will arrange to meet with the bereaved family and will guide the family through the choices of scripture readings and music.
- The Pastor or his designate will preside at the Funeral Mass or Funeral Service (Liturgy of the Word without Mass) at the Basilica.
- The Funeral Mass or Funeral Service and other Funeral Rites a Vigil Service, Closing of Casket, Rite of Committal will be offered to the bereaved family.

Music for Funerals

- Music is chosen in the same way as at Sunday Mass and the hymns are chosen from Catholic Book of Worship III &/or Celebrate in Song for which we have a license. These are the hymn books for which we have a license. Songs other than hymns can be sung at the graveside or at a wake vigil.
- The Organist and Cantor (trained musicians) are provided by the Basilica Parish. If the family
 desires an outside singer, he/she may sing an appropriate hymn at the Offertory or at a part of the
 Funeral Service. All parts of the Mass are sung and the Basilica musicians are familiar with this
 music.

LIVESTREAMING OF FUNERALS (NEW)

The Basilica Heritage Foundation is solely responsible for Livestreaming all events in the Basilica. It requires broadcasting, music, and software copyright licenses, as well as trained technicians. Therefore, as of November, 2021, there will be a nominal fee of 100.00 for livestreaming of funerals. Please advise the Parish as soon as you can if you want the funeral livestreamed. Should the family require a video recording of the funeral Liturgy, or for any other information, please contact the parish office or email the Basilica Heritage Foundation.
